Notice of Race & Sailing Instructions

November 1 & 2, 2008

A Lakewide event open to members of LNYC, OYC & PYC to benefit The Lake Norman Keelboat Council

Organizing Authority: Outrigger Yacht Club

Rules: This event will be governed by the "Rules" as outlined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), available at www.USSailing.org, except as altered by the current Lakewide Sailing Instructions (LSI), available at www.lnkc.com, the Wilmer Trophy Deed of Gift and these Sailing Instructions. Notices to competitors and changes to sailing instructions will be posted at www.outriggeryachtclub.org. Races will be a minimum of 8.9 miles each with a time limit of three and one half hours for the spinnaker fleet only. Non-Spinnaker boats may compete for the Wilmer Trophy, but must register and race in the Spinnaker fleet.

Eligibility: Eligible Members of Outrigger Yacht Club, Lake Norman Yacht Club and Peninsula Yacht Club may enter a qualified keelboat with a LNKC PHRF Rating Certificate by completing and returning the Entry Form along with payment of the appropriate fees. If the vessel to be entered does not have a current LNKC PHRF Certificate, a temporary rating may be obtained by completing a LNKC PHRF Rating Request Form (found at the www.lnkc.com) and returning it with the Entry Form. A boat shall not be scored unless all of its entry requirements are met.

Classes: Entrants shall be divided into Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker Fleets and may be further split into divisions.

Fees: US Sailing Member \$35.00 (Membership Number required)

Non US Sailing Member Add \$ 5.00

Late Registration fee Add \$10.00 (Postmarked after 10-27-08)

Awards and results will be made available at Midtown Sundries, Cornelius, NC following Race #2.

The Start: The starting line will be in the vicinity of Marker 2 between a floating mark and the "RC" flagstaff on the Committee Boat which, along with any limiting buoy and attachment line placed for the protection of the race committee boat and crew, is a starting *mark*. This changes the RRS definition for a *mark* only as it refers to the race committee boat. There will be one start for both fleets. The Class Flag will be the Numeral Flag 1. The Preparatory Signal will be the Flag P. Course signals and any flag that makes part of Rule 30 applicable will be displayed separate from the starting sequence signals. This changes RRS 26 and the Preparatory Signals in Race Signals.

The Course: The course marks as outlined in the current LSI shall apply. RC may provide separate courses for the Spinnaker vs. the Non-spinnaker fleets by signaling the Spinnaker Course under Flag "S" and the Non-Spinnaker Course under Flag "N" on separate flagstaffs.

Time Limit: The time limit to the first mark is waived for this event. This changes LSI Rule 14.1.

Scoring: The Low Point Scoring System A2 shall apply, except that all races shall be scored.

Safety: Each boat shall be equipped with safety gear, as required by federal, state, and local regulations. Any boat retiring before finishing is required to inform the RC before leaving the racecourse.

Missing Channel Markers and/or Course Marks: If a Channel Marker and/or Course Mark are/is missing, RC may replace it with a temporary floating mark that may not display flag M. This changes RRS 34 (b).

Protests: Competitors are encouraged to resolve all protests on the water according to the 'rules'. If the protest cannot be resolved on the water, the protesting party must inform the Committee Boat prior to leaving the Race Area of their intent to submit a written protest, then properly completed protest forms must be submitted to the Race Committee within 60 minutes after their arrival at the dock after the race.

Trophies: Trophies will be awarded to the top two finishers in each division. The name of the overall winner in the spinnaker fleet will be engraved onto the Wilmer Trophy on display at Lake Norman Yacht Club, given that the requirements of the deed of gift are met. If either race does not qualify under the Wilmer Trophy Deed of Gift, the Wilmer Trophy recognition will not be awarded.
