Notice of Race & Sailing Instructions

Date: May 1-3, 2009

An Open event benefiting the
Chuck Strange Foundation for Adaptive Sailing
and the **North Carolina Community Sailing & Rowing Center**

Organizing Authority and Host Club: The Outrigger Yacht Club

Rules: This event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), available at www.ussailing.org. The Lake Norman Keelboat Council Lakewide Sailing Instructions (LSI), available at www.lnkc.com, will apply.

Eligibility: This regatta is open to any keelboat with a current Lake Norman Keelboat Council PHRF Rating Certificate or a centerboard sailboat of at least 17' LOA with a Portsmouth rating that will be converted to PHRF by submitting the completed Entry Form with payment of appropriate fees. If the boat does not have a current LNKC PHRF Certificate, a temporary rating must be obtained by properly completing a LNKC PHRF Rating Request Form (available on the website) and returning it with the Entry Form. While racing, a boat shall have on board a person who is eligible to enter a boat in this event. A boat will not be scored unless all eligibility requirements are met.

Classes: Entrants will be divided into Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker Fleets and may be further divided into Divisions. Fleet declarations may not be changed once the Skipper's Meeting has begun. Division ribbons to be flown from the backstay of each boat will be provided at the Skipper's Meeting.

Fees: As outlined on the Entry Form. Fees include food/beverage for the entire weekend except for cash bar on Saturday afternoon @ Midtown Sundries, one tee shirt, race support, and trophies. Persons other than the registrants (Crew, significant others, dates, friends, etc.) are expected to make appropriate donations as outlined for food and beverage. To avoid late fee, entry must be postmarked no later than April 24, 2009.

Schedule of events:

Friday, May 1, 2009 : Skipper's Meeting & Social/Cookout @ Kings Point Marina Clubhouse, Cornelius, NC. Social starts at 5:00 PM, Race registration ends at 7:00 PM, Skipper's Meeting to start ASAP thereafter. \$5 per additional persons other than registered skipper. Additional donations to the cause will be accepted. Raffle tickets will be available.

Saturday, May 2, 2009 : 10:30 AM - Warning signal, Race 1 in the vicinity of Marker 2. Race 2 to start ASAP after completion of Race 1.

3:00 PM or ASAP after racing: BBQ buffet and cash bar at Midtown Sundries, Cornelius, NC. Every attempt will be made to have race results for the day available. **\$5 per additional persons other than registered skipper** for food. Additional donations to the cause will be accepted. Raffle tickets will be available.

Sunday, May 3 2009 : 10:30 AM - Warning signal, Race 3 in the vicinity of Marker 2. **If both races on Saturday** are abandoned, RC *may* attempt to stage a second race to start ASAP after the completion of the first race of the day. If RC determines to run a second race on Sunday, an "L" flag will be flying on the Race Committee Boat (CB) at the finish of race #1.

2:30 PM or ASAP after racing: Awards ceremony, raffle/auction, and fish fry at Kings Point Marina Clubhouse, Cornelius, NC. Additional donations to the cause will be accepted. **\$10 per additional persons other than registered skipper**. Raffle tickets will be available. Mariner Villas is located in just off W. Catawba Ave. at Sam Furr Road (Hwy 73).

Courses: The course marks as outlined in the current LSI shall apply. A signal flag flown from the Committee Boat will identify which of the courses outlined in the Sailing Instructions provided at the Skipper's Meeting is to be sailed.

Starts/Scoring: The boat with the highest PHRF rating will start first and the boat with the lowest PHRF rating will start last. The time differentials between the start for the first boat and all pursuing boats will be provided at the Skipper's Meeting as will and sailing instructions with course information. Boats will be scored in their order of finish. On water check in is not required and competitors may operate their motors until five minutes before their scheduled start. This changes LSI 9.1 and RRS 42.1. Each boat will remain clear of the starting line area until five minutes prior to its scheduled start time and yield to those who are starting. The Class Flag will numeral Flag 1. The preparatory signal will always be the Flag P. The Race Committee Boat (CB), along with any limiting buoy and attachment line placed for the protection of it and its crew, is a starting *mark*. This changes the RRS definition for a *mark* only as it refers to the CB. Course signals and any flag that makes part of Rule 30 applicable will be displayed separate of the Starting Sequence signals. This changes Rules 26 and 27.1 and the Preparatory Signals in Race Signals. Boats over early will be signaled with one sound signal and flag X, however flag X will be lowered prior to the start of the next scheduled competitor. This changes RRS 29.1. One race will constitute a Regatta.

The starting signals sequence for the first boat to start, and to begin the countdown for all pursuing boats to start, is as described below:

As a courtesy, there will be two sound signals one minute prior to the Warning Signal.

<u>Signal</u>	<u>Flag and Sound</u>	<u>Minutes before Starting signal</u>	
Warning	#1 Flag - 1 sound	5	<u>Note:</u> Times shall be taken from the visual signals; the absence of a sound signal shall be disregarded.
Preparatory	P Flag - 1 sound	4	
One-minute	P Flag removed -1 long sound	1	
Starting	#1 Flag removed -1 sound	0	

Missing Channel Markers or Course Marks: If a Channel Marker or Course Mark is missing, RC may replace it with a temporary floating mark that may not display Flag "M" and without any sound signal(s). This changes RRS 34.

Protests: Competitors are encouraged to resolve all protest on the water. Otherwise, the protesting party must inform the CB prior to leaving the Race Area of their intent to submit a written protest. Properly completed protest forms must be submitted to the RC within 2 hours of the last boat finishing for the day. A protest hearing will be convened as soon as possible thereafter.

Trophies: Trophies will be awarded to the first two finishers in each Division.
