Notice of Race & Sailing Instructions

Rules: This event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), available at www.ussailing.org, the Lake Norman Keelboat Council's (LNKC) Lakewide Sailing Instructions (LSI), available at www.lnkc.com, and these Sailing Instructions.

Eligibility: Registration is open to any keelboat with a current Lake Norman Keelboat Council PHRF Rating Certificate by submitting the completed Entry Form with payment of appropriate fees. If the boat does not have a current LNKC PHRF Certificate, a temporary rating must be obtained by properly completing a LNKC PHRF Rating Request Form (available at www.lnkc.com website) and returning it with the Entry Form at least one week prior to the event. To qualify for a rating, the boat must be a ballasted, self-righting monohull of at least 20 feet in overall length. A boat will not be scored unless all eligibility requirements are met.

Classes: Entrants will be divided into Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker Fleets and may be further divided into Divisions. One design keelboats, J80, J24, San Juan 21, U20 and others, are encouraged to participate. A fleet of five or more one design boats will receive an individual start. Fleet declarations may not be changed after the conclusion of race registration at Skippers Meeting.

Schedule of events:

Friday, October 1, 2010: 6:00 PM - **Skipper's Meeting & Social** at Kings Point Marina Clubhouse, Cornelius, NC. Social starts at 6:00 PM, Race registration ends at 7:00 PM, Skipper's Meeting to start ASAP thereafter. **\$10 per additional persons other than registered skipper.** Additional donations to the cause will be accepted. Raffle tickets will be available.

Saturday, October 2, 2010: 10:55 AM - **Warning signal for the first fleet.** One medium distance race is planned. Each fleet will have an individual starting time. One design fleets (J-80, J24, U20, San Juan 21 or other) with 5 or more boats will have individual starting times. Fleet designations will be identified at the skippers meeting.

Saturday, October 2, 2010: 6:30 PM – **Dinner, Auction and Awards** ceremony at Galway Hooker located at Kenton Place, northeast of NC Highway 73 and Catawba Avenue, Cornelius, NC. **\$30 per additional persons other than registered skipper.** Additional donations to the cause will be accepted. Raffle tickets will be available.

Starts/Scoring: The starting line will lie in the vicinity of the Shoal Marker (SM) 0.4 NM WNW of channel marker 2. Spinnaker, non spinnaker, and one design fleets are anticipated. All fleets will have individual starts. Class Flags will be identified at the skippers meeting. The preparatory signal will be the Flag P. After the start of the first fleet, the “A” flag shall be flown from the Committee Boat signifying that another race is to be started. The “A” flag will be lowered one minute before the warning signal for the next start and will be accompanied by two sound signals. All boats whose warning signal has not been given will remain clear of the starting area.

Missing Channel Markers or Course Marks: RC may replace a missing Marker or Course Mark with a temporary floating mark that may not display Flag "M" and without any sound signal(s). This changes RRS 34.

Protests: Competitors are encouraged to resolve all protest on the water according to the rules. Otherwise, the protesting party must inform the CB prior to leaving the Race Area of their intent to submit a written protest. Properly completed protest forms must be submitted to the RC within 2 hours of the last boat finishing for the day. A protest hearing will be convened as soon as possible thereafter.

Awards: Trophies will be awarded to the first two finishers in each Division.
