

LNYS Keelboat Invitational Series 2010

Notice of Race

1 RULES

- 1.1 LNYS Club Series races will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS).
- 1.2 For one-design classes, boats shall comply with rules of their class.
- 1.3 The July 4th Regatta will be included in Club Series Scoring for the Spring Series, the Labor Day Regatta will be included in the Club Series Scoring for the Fall Series.

2 ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- 2.1 This event is open to all PHRF and One Design keelboats 20' LOA and longer, whose skipper meets the criterion in 2.2.
- 2.2 This event is open to LNYS members, and nonmembers invited and hosted by LNYS members. Non-club members may enter by completing an entry form and waiver available at lakenormanyachtclub.com, and by paying the required fees.

3 FUNDAMENTAL RULES AND SAFETY

- 4.1 Each competitor shall be familiar with the requirements of the RRS, including Part 1 "Fundamental Rules".

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Race dates are as follows:
 - 4.1.1 Spring Series: 4/10, 4/24, 5/15, 6/5, 6/19, 7/3, 7/4 (All dates except 7/4 are Saturdays.)
 - 4.1.2 Fall Series: 7/17, 8/14, 8/28, 9/4, 9/5, 10/2, 10/23 (All dates except 9/5 are Saturdays.)
- 4.2 Competitors shall be prepared for an 1100 Warning Signal for the first race of each day.
- 4.3 No warning signal will be made after 1600.
- 4.4 The racing schedule for the July 4th Regatta and Labor Day Regatta will be as stated in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions for those events.

5 SCORING

- 5.1 Two boats will constitute a fleet to qualify as a fleet Start.
- 5.2 "Low Point Scoring" as defined by RRS Appendix A4 will be used.
- 5.3 "Series Scores" will be computed as stated in RRS Appendix A2 and as stated under Section 8. Additionally, RRS Appendix A9 will be in effect and is modified by deleting the last sentence.
- 5.4 Members serving on Race Committee will be scored as a boat that came to the starting area but did not start. This must be requested to the PRO or Scorer.
PHRF keelboats will be scored based on the LNKC Handicap ratings.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at the LNYS Race Management Center before the start of the first race of the season. Additional copies may be printed from the LNYS website.

7 COURSES

- 7.1 One design classes will sail "around the buoys".
- 7.2 PHRF Spinnaker fleets will sail "around the buoys".
- 7.3 PHRF Non-Spin and/or Cruiser fleet will sail "down the Lake" or "around the buoys" at RC's discretion.

8 QUALIFYING FOR STANDINGS AND AWARDS

- 8.1 Standings
 - 8.1.1 Standings have qualifying criteria for both the fleet and the individuals or boats within the fleet.
 - 8.1.2 Before a fleet is considered qualified for awards, that fleet must participate in at least 50% of the Club Series Races sailed in that series.
 - 8.1.3 In calculating the number of races required, decimals will be carried to one place. The values of 0.5 and greater will be rounded up to the nearest whole number, while 0.4 and lower will be rounded down to the nearest whole number.
 - 8.1.4 A boat's standing in the Spring and Fall Series will be based on his/her best finishes in 60% of the races sailed by that fleet.
- 8.2 Awards
 - 8.2.1 Trophies for the Spring and Fall Series will be awarded to individuals in each qualified fleet that race at least 60% of the that fleet's starts.
- 8.3 Trophies (Based on Average number of qualifying boats)
