NOTICE OF RACE

(May 14th, June 18th, August 12th)



1. RULES

- 1.1. This race series will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-2012 and the Lake Norman Keelboat Council (LNKC) Lake-wide Sailing Instructions (LSI) 2009-2012, except where altered by this notice of race.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. This series is open to all mono-hull sailboats with a valid LNKC PHRF rating certificate. If a boat does not have a LNKC PHRF rating certificate, a rating will be assigned based on LNKC "historic" rating for a boat in her class.
- 2.2. A minimum of three boats shall constitute a class.
- 2.3. All boats should have appropriate navigation lights in operation for night sailing.
- 2.4. Eligible boats may enter online at LNYC.org or by completing the attached form and sending it, together with all required fees to:

- 2.5. Those registering online may pay registration fees at the skippers' meeting the night of the first race.

3. FEES

- 3.1. Required fees for the Moonlight Series are as follows:

5. CLASSES

5.1. Entrants may register for Spinnaker or Non-Spinnaker classes. These may be further divided based on the number of entries. Declarations on the entry form will not be changed once the competitor has checked in for his/her first race. Three boats constitute a class.

6. NUMBER OF RACES

6.1. The series will consist of three races, one race per race date.

6.2. One completed race will constitute a series.

- 7.1. The Lake Norman Yacht Club is the organizing authority and host of the Lake Norman Yacht Club Moonlight Series.

- 9.1. All races will be held on Lake Norman and will start in an area generally to the east of the Lake Norman Yacht Club.

10. THE COURSES

- 10.1. The course will be posted on the committee boat at the start of each race/class.

11. SCORING

- 11.1. The Time on Distance Low Point Scoring System shall apply for the PHRF classes. Straight time will apply for one-design classes.
