- 1. <u>Rules</u>: The Regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing and Class Rules, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions.
- 2. <u>Eligibility and Entry</u>: The regatta is open to keelboats with a current LNKC PHRF rating Certificate. If the boat has not been rated, submit pertinent information to the Lake Norman Keelboat Council at http://www.lnkc.com to have a provisional rating assigned. No rating will be changed after completing registration.
- <u>Classes</u>: Entrants will be divided into Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker Fleets and may be further divided into Divisions. One Design Starts will be given to fleets that have a minimum of five like boats pre-registered.

- 7. **Race Area:** The racing area will be on Lake Norman in close proximity to the Lake Norman Yacht Club.
- 8. **The Courses:** The courses to be sailed will be windward-leeward, around the buoys. Six races are scheduled. One race completed, shall constitute a regatta.

9. Scoring:

- a. When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- b. When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her scores excluding her worst score. The PHRF Handicap System will be used and the Time on Distance Low Point Scoring System A2 shall apply; there will be one throw-out after five races sailed.
