L at 3rd traffic light, Brawley School Road  
- 2 shopping centers at Williamson and Brawley School (Lowes Foods, Harris Teeter)  
5.3 miles on Brawley School Road to traffic circle  
2nd R on traffic circle, still Brawley School Road  
.5 miles on Brawley School Road  
1st L on Yacht Road.  
- Lake Norman Yacht Club sign is on the corner  
.8 miles on Yacht Road  
L into Lake Norman Yacht Club  
R on driveway to clubhouse and registration

I-77S to Exit 36  
R at exit on Hwy 150  
.4 miles on Hwy 150  
L at 3rd traffic light, Williamson Road  
- CVS and Country Corner Marine at Hwy 150 and Williamson  
.9 miles on Williamson Road  
R at 2nd traffic light, Brawley School Road  
- 2 shopping centers at Williamson and Brawley School (Harris Teeter, Lowes Foods)
